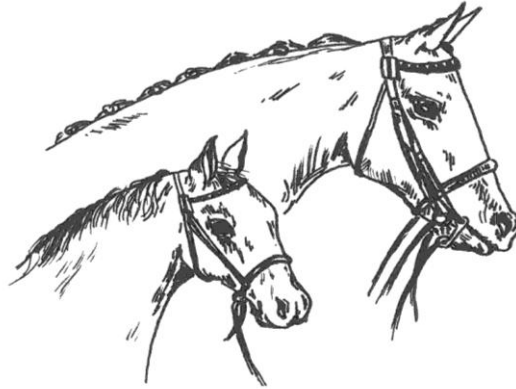

This Show is a Qualifier for the 2020 N.C.P.A. Pony of the Year Show and the Part Bred Welsh Ridden Championships to be held in conjunction with the Pony of the Year Show at Warren Farm Equestrian Centre, Formby, Lancashire L37 0AN on Sunday 5th September 2020. First, second and third prizewinners in appropriate classes will qualify and highest not qualified in the first six for Part Bred Welsh in appropriate classes. ALL champions and reserve champions at any NCPA Branch Show will receive a GOLDEN TICKET to qualify for the Golden Supreme Championships to be held at the Pony of the Year Show. Entry for the championships is FREE however competitors MUST be members of the NCPA and ENTER AT LEAST one other class at the championships. Prize money at the final is: 1st £500, 2nd £300, 3rd £100, 4th £50, 5th £25 and £25 for each supreme.

This show is a Qualifier for the NCPA Junior Mountain & Moorland Pony of the Year to be held at the 2020 N.C.P.A Pony of the Year Show. The highest placed pony and rider not already qualified in the first five will qualify. Qualification will go not lower than fifth place. Classes will be marked on a 50/50 mark system. The following classes are qualifiers:

NCPA Junior Mountain & Moorland Ridden Small Breeds: Registered Pure Bred Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A & B Mares or Geldings 4yr old or over. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year.

NCPA Junior Mountain & Moorland Ridden Large Breeds: Registered Pure Bred Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C & D Mares or Geldings 4yr old or over. Riders not to have attained their 18th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year.

This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (“B.S.P.S.”), and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S. classes, whether or not members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Rules of the B.S.P.S, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.

This Show is affiliated to the Royal International Horse Show. The highest placed pony not already qualified from the first three ponies in Classes 35 - 40 Pretty Polly Classes will qualify. Owners & riders must be B.S.P.S. members before the date of the show to compete in the classes with qualification for R.I.H.S. and Blue Riband animals must be registered with the B.S.P.S.

This Show is a qualifier for the 2020 B.S.P.S Classic Services Group Challenge. The following will qualify Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Open Show Pony, Open Show Hunter Pony, Cradle Stakes, Nursery Stakes, Open Working Hunter Pony, the Open Intermediate SRT, SH, WH and Heritage classes. The highest placed pony that has not qualified for the 2020 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class will qualify. If after qualifying for the Challenge a pony qualifies for HOYS it will forfeit its qualification for the “BSPS Challenge” **Please refer to Rule 453 in the 2020 BSPS Handbook**

This Show is a qualifier for the 2020 B.S.P.S. Championships Show, to be held at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincs. The 1st and 2nd prize winners only in the following classes Lead Rein & First Ridden, open show pony and Nursery Stakes and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners in the Open Intermediate S.R.T. (including Mixed Height) W.H. and S.H.T. and C.S will qualify. In MIXED HEIGHT CLASSES the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed ponies will qualify for the B.S.P.S. Championships Show, provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 21 and 26 and ridden by a BSPS member.

This Show is affiliated to the 2020 Equifest Showing Show, taking place at the East of England Showground on the 19th – 23rd August 2020. Qualification cards will no longer be sent to the Show Secretary. Instead it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have a qualification card before entering the show and getting this signed by either the Judge, Steward or Show Secretary at the time of qualification. Qualification cards will be sent out free of charge to exhibitors on request. Equifest qualifier classes also carry a dual qualification with Ponies (UK) Championships. Please see the relevant website for information regarding these qualifiers.

This show is affiliated to the **SHB(GB)** Rules as per the 2020 handbook. Owners & riders have to be current SHB (GB) members in all ridden classes. The organisers of the show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid & prevent accidents occurring & must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the Officials & Stewards.

RIHS qualifying classes – Classes 1 – 6 & 26 are qualifying classes for the RIHS 2020 and only horses registered on the 2020 register are eligible to enter. Novice Working Hunter Rules state not to have won a total of £200 or 5 BE Points or 200 BS Points.

Day Ticket = £36 (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 show's in the year – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days.

ALL COMPETITORS MUST wear Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards: All PAS 015; VG1; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. It is mandatory for competitors under the age of 18 to wear such skull caps or hats. In the jumping phase of working hunter classes the aforementioned skull caps/riding hats must be worn.

Working hunter. Open to mares, geldings, stallions (must wear red, white & blue ribbon in tail) 4yrs old & over exceeding 148cms to be judged in accordance with SHB of GB rules. Grade A show-jumpers & Advanced Event horses not eligible to compete in these classes. The maximum total points available is 100. This is made up of: Jumping points = Max 40 points, Style & Presence whilst Jumping = Max 20 points, Ride/Manners = Max 20 points, Conformation = max 20 points.

AMATEUR STATUS: A person is an amateur for showing purposes when showing ridden hunters if she or he does not during the current or previous year:

- a) Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity or as a means of deriving a main source of income.
- b) Accept remuneration whether it be monetary or goods in kind for employment in connection with horses in a racing, showing, livery stables or riding school. (Instruction at Pony Club or Riding Clubs excepted)
- c) Show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial form or a horse for which his or her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate concern. **In addition persons classes as Amateur must not be supported by a company in any way or act as a Brand Ambassador**
- d) Show a horse which a professional rider has ridden in any ridden hunter or ridden Sport Horse class during the current year, with the exception of working hunter classes & ladies hunter classes unless the horse has subsequently re-registered under new ownership.
- e) Professional show persons must not enter the Amateur ring whilst the class is in progress. A professional show person is another term for a professional producer and as such a professional groom who works for a producer can enter the ring to groom.
- f) A professional rider must not ride or exercise an amateur's horse on the day it is competing in amateur classes.
- g) A competitor is not eligible to compete in Amateur classes on an exhibit which has been qualified for either the R.I.H.S or H.O.Y.S by a professional during the current season except in Ladies and Working Hunter classes
- h) Amateur Home Produced – Horses which are either stabled at home or in a DIY yard and which since 1st January 2019 have not been shown by a professional during the current season or stabled in a professional yard at any time in 2019. Must be ridden by an Amateur. This does not exclude the Amateur Owner Home Produced riders having lessons at any time with an instructor, providing the horse remains stabled at home or in a DIY yard.
- i) **Own/part own an equestrian establishment including but not limited to riding schools, events centre, stud or livery yard in any capacity or receive any form of remuneration for employment at an equestrian establishment. For avoidance of doubt for the purpose of this rule immediate family members of an owner or part owner of an equestrian establishment who work or are howsoever otherwise engaged or involved in any capacity whether or not for remuneration at the equestrian establishment will be treated as being an owner or part owner of that establishment.**

ROYAL INTERNATIONALHORSE SHOW (“RIHS”)

The Society designates certain Shows as qualifying shows for the RIHS at which horses may qualify for the RIHS in the current year or at specific shows for the following year. At these Shows the two highest placed horses in the Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight, Small and Ladies (side saddle) Classes will qualify to enter at the RIHS. No horse lower than second will qualify. In the Working Hunter class the three highest placed horses will qualify. No horse lower than third will qualify. If there is a Working Hunter Championship made up of the first and second prize winners from the light and heavyweight working hunter classes respectively, these four horses will qualify for RIHS unless they have already done so. Where there is only one amateur ridden hunter class the two highest placed smalls, the two highest placed lightweights, the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify. When there are two classes, in the lightweight section, the two highest placed smalls and the two highest placed lightweights will qualify and in the heavyweight section the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify.

This Show is a Qualifier for the 2020 NPS Area 4 Northern Breeders Championships sponsored by “M P Gloss Products UK LTD” to be held at the NPS Area 4 North of England Show on Monday 31st August 2020. The champion and reserve champion in the Mountain and Moorland Supreme In Hand championship will qualify. Qualifiers do not have to be members of the NPS.

TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals - This show is a qualifier for the 2020 TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR NAF Five Star Riders Finals - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification flyer in the ring.

TSR NAF Five Star In Hand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand sheet will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their sheet signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>

Equifest & BSHA Intro Championships - With a TSR qualification flyer you can also enter Equifest 19th-22nd August at Peterborough www.equifest.org.uk & the BSHA Intro Champs in Sept at Addington Equestrian Centre - You do not have to be a BSHA member to qualify or enter the final. See <http://www.britishshowhorse.org>

TSR Medal Awards - TSR members can collect qualification cards & signatures and redeem for a TSR Medal see TSR website for details.

This Show is a qualifier for the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) £2000 Challenge. The highest placed horse (not already qualified) from the each of the following class 8 will qualify for the final of the IDHS (GB) which will be held at the IDHS (GB) Annual Breed Show on 22nd & 23rd August 2020 at Arena UK, Allington, Grantham, Lincolnshire NG32 2EF. N.B A horse may only qualify for the final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered. Each qualifier will receive a card. Qualifiers are required to complete an online form at www.idhs.gb.com to inform the IDHS (GB) that they have qualified for the final. In the final, the champion will be awarded £1000 in prize money and a trophy. The reserve champion will be awarded £500 and 3rd to 7th place inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, the highest placed Pure Bred Irish Draught will receive a trophy and £100 and the highest placed Sport Horse will receive a trophy and £50.

Irish Draught Ridden Class 8 Conditions of Entry

Class 8 is affiliated to the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) and only horses registered with, or overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and in the correct ownership are eligible for entry. The owners of all Pure Bred Irish Draught horses in ridden classes MUST BE full members of the IDHS (GB). This rule does not apply to owners of Irish Draught Sport Horses. Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form and entries will be sent to the IDHS (GB) prior to the show to confirm eligibility.

ALL competing STALLIONS must be the progeny of a Graded Mare (ID Class 1, Class 2, RID (GB) AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID (GB) stallion and be inspected or overstamped by the IDHS (GB), ID Class 1 or ID Class 2 OR be a registered Irish Draught Sport Horse Stallion and they must display a red, white and blue ribbon in their tails.

ALL riders of STALLIONS MUST be 18 years or age or over. All ridden horses must be 153cms (15hh) or over.

This show is affiliated to the Shetland Pony Stud Book Society. www.shetlandponystudbooksociety.co.uk

Classes must be confined to Registered Ponies. Ponies **must be named on the entry form** and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or eligible for registration (i.e. foals)

Three-year-old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the Show. All entire males aged 2 years and over must display a stallion disc.

There must be no colts or entire males in Young Handlers classes. Children under 14 yrs old may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in In-hand classes. Children under 12 yrs old on the day of the show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In the interests of safety, hard hats must be worn by all handlers aged 14 yrs or under in In-hand classes. Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the ring. Hard hats must be worn by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. In ridden Classes, if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.

This show is affiliated to Equine Sports UK (ESUK) Grassroots Championships taking place at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on the 6th - 9th August 2020. The three highest placed exhibits will qualify in each class” Please go to www.equinesportsuk.co.uk for clarification.

SHOW RULES

It is a condition of entry that Exhibitors agree to be bound by the rules here with under Any objection must be made in writing with a deposit of £50.00 in cash, (refundable if the objection is upheld), within 30 minutes of the class taking place.

The organising Committee accept no responsibility whatsoever for any loss, injury or damage to any person or their property whilst on the showground, car parks or approaches.

THE N.C.P.A DOES NOT allow anyone to bring their horses or ponies to ride or walk round at the show WITHOUT entering a class due to the N.C.P.A Public liability INSURANCE Ruling. Anyone found to be breaking this rule will be asked to leave the showground immediately.

Entry fees will not be refunded and it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that their entry is correct, eligible and available when called for their class. Exhibitors must take into consideration that classes may clash. If this occurs, they must nominate which class they wish to compete in. No classes will be held up for any competitor.

IT IS THE RULE OF NEWARK SHOWGROUND AND THE N.C.P.A that a correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos AllPAS015, VGI, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELLE2001, AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards MUST Be worn by competitors, riders and judges at ALL TIMES whilst mounted. FOR BSPS CLASSES SEE RULE 45 IN THE BSPS HANDBOOK.

Entries for affiliated classes will also be bound by the Rules and Conditions in force at the time of showing, applicable to that Association and the class in which they are exhibiting. It is deemed by the organising Committee that exhibitors are conversant with any such rules, conditions or directives.

The organising Committee reserve the right to amalgamate or split classes and alter or amend the running order of classes. In the event of a show being cancelled, entry fees, less a £10.00 deduction for administration charges, will be refunded.

The Committee reserves the right to expel any animal from the ring which in their opinion is not deemed to be fit or under sufficient control.

Show canes or whips to be no longer than 75 cms/30 inches.

Horses/ponies which have been bred, sold, leased or produced by the Judge, his/her immediate family or Employer are not eligible for that class.

Mountain and Moorland ponies must be:-

- a) Shown in their natural state.
- b) Registered with their respective Pure Breed Society.
- c) Registration number quoted on entry forms.

Stallions and colts must be adequately bitted and under the control of a competent rider/handler

PLEASE NOTE: It is the rule of NPS & Ponies UK that Stallions/Colts may not be led by any juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday before January 1st in the current year.
